(1) Financial Support

EASTS provides financial support (conference registration, airfare and accommodation fees) only for the EASTS regular members, who present the Academic Papers or **Practical Paper** with the excellent review results and belong to the following EASTS member countries/regions/societies which meet the criteria for EASTS' fund beneficiaries: Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, and Mongolia.

(2) New Journal Publication

A new journal 'Asian Transport Studies' will be published in addition to the existing EASTS Journal. This new journal is expected to appeal the characteristics of EASTS and will be highly evaluated in the world. Papers in the new journal will be selected among the submitted Academic Papers or **Practical Papers** that deal with the Asian specific topics or case studies in Asia with high quality or great promise. Excellent **Practical Papers** have opportunity to obtain Awards in the Conference as well as Academic Papers.

(3) Requirement of Membership of EASTS for Your Presentation

Those who want to present your paper(s) in the Conference should have an "EASTS Regular Member ID". Any paper submitted without ID cannot be presented nor included in the

III. Tips from International Scientific Committee (ISC)

(1) Encouragement to submit Practical Papers

We strongly promote the participation of practical experts who belong to governments and/or transportation-relating businesses. We make much of active discussions between experts and researchers at the Conference. Thus, we have set up a 'Practical Papers' category since the Dalian Conference. The 'Practical Papers' cover the practical issues and problems with good suggestions for transportation system in the Eastern Asia region. As the evaluation process for Practical Papers is simpler than that for Academic Papers, **we expect many Practical Papers dealing with timely and useful topics such as on-going transportation projects, recent issues or practical comments on transportation policies, etc.** The paper review of Practical Papers respects their usefulness, timeliness, reliability, and practical novelty rather than completeness or academic originality. The accepted Practical Papers will be presented at the Conference.

(2) Conference CD-ROM, Proceedings and Journal Publication

ISC publishes the following three publications: Conference CD-ROM, Proceedings of EASTS and the Journal of EASTS. First, the Conference CD-ROM contains all papers qualified for conference presentation. It includes both Academic Papers and Practical Papers. The advanced registration is required for their papers to be included in the Conference CD-ROM. This CD-ROM is published before the Conference. Secondly, the Proceedings of the EASTS contains all papers that have **been presented** at the Conference. It includes both Academic Papers and Practical Papers. The Proceedings will be uploaded to the J-Stage web site after the conference. Note that any paper that has not been presented at the Conference cannot be contained in the Proceedings. Thirdly, the Journal of the EASTS contains the refereed Academic Papers that have been qualified through the paper review process. The presentation at the Conference is required for their papers to be included in the Journal. Papers that will be contained in the new Journal are not included in

this existing Journal. The Journal will be provided through the J-Stage web site after the Conference.

Finally, **the new Journal contains excellent Academic Papers and Practical Papers that have been presented at the conference.** The Journal will be provided through the J-Stage website periodically.
